New options for Medication Assisted Treatment for Opioid Dependence (MATOD) Prescribing Training

All medical practitioners can apply for authorities to treat up to 5 patients with Buprenorphine/naloxone (Suboxone®) for opioid dependence.

To prescribe methadone, buprenorphine (Subutex®) or buprenorphine/naloxone (Suboxone®) for more than 5 patients a medical practitioner must be accredited.

DASSA offers training to become an accredited MATOD prescriber that involves:

Skill Development – ½ day activity completed using standardised patients supervised by an experienced MATOD prescriber.
